Emanuel Tunbjer, Founder, Partner & Senior Advisor / Trainer at We Are Movement – *Lean Portfolio Management*

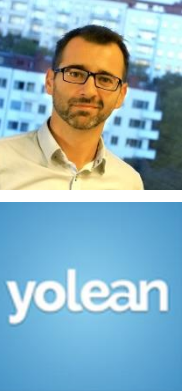

Key take away: Visual planning utilising pull with questions + ownership is key!
