
## What Does a Project Manager Do?







## Scrum is a simple team-based framework

"...modeled on patterns of high-performance product development."





## Scrum is a simple team-based framework

"A product has a life-cycle, not an end date. You don't know what will be successful until the customer or user tells you it's a success."

#### **Accountabilities**

- Creating a valuable, useful increment every sprint
- Have all the skills and authority necessary to create value each sprint



The Essentials:

Inspect and Adapt

- All product-related activities
- Stakeholder collaboration
- Decide who does what, when, and how.
- Define the sprint goal.
- Presents results of their work to key stakeholders.
- Review what was accomplished.
- Increase own quality and effectiveness.



### Scrum Product Owner in a nutshell

"The Product Owner creates a clear line-of-sight from those doing the work to those who will benefit from the work."

#### **Accountabilities**

- Maximize the value of the product
- Manage the Product Backlog

#### **Key questions**

Ask Stakeholders: Why?
Answer Developers: Why?



#### The Essentials:

One person, part of the team.

- Make decisions about the product.
- Develop & communicate the product goal.
- Create & communicate product backlog items.
- Order product backlog.
- Ensure that the product backlog is transparent, visible and understood.
- Proposes how to increase product value each sprint.
- May cancel a sprint.




### Scrum Developers in a nutshell

"By having all the necessary skills, the Developers can do more than implement solutions. They can solve problems."

#### **Accountabilities**

- Create the product increment each sprint
- Create a plan for the sprint
- Instill quality
- Adapt the plan each day
- Hold each other accountable



#### Responsibilities

- Select items from the product backlog.
- Plan the work necessary to create an increment.
- Select structure and techniques for the Daily Scrum.
- Attend the Daily Scrum.
- Conform to the Definition of Done.

#### **Key Questions**

Answer: How? How big?
Ask: Why?

The Essentials:

All the needed skills to create the product



### Scrum Master in a nutshell


"Too many Scrum Master job descriptions focus on duties that are not mentioned in the Scrum Guide."

- Establishing Scrum
- Team effectiveness

#### **Key Message**

The Essentials:

Voice of the Common Sense

- Enable team to improve.
- · Coach team members.
- Help the Scrum team focus on creating value.
- Cause removal of impediments.
- Lead, train & coach the organization on Scrum.
- Remove barriers to stakeholder access.
- Ensure that Scrum events are positive, productive, and time-boxed.



## Where is the Project Manager in Scrum?

"Products have a life-cycle, not an end-date. Therefore, a Scrum team does not have a project manager, nor does it report to a project manager."



- Issue Resolution



# A new approach is challenging (some of) the assumptions of lean production

Optimize to reduce variance

**Optimize for innovation** 







### Remember this...



The driving force is the need to innovate faster.



Scrum achieves high performance by accelerating decision cycles and delivering frequent updates.



Scrum moves decision-making from outside the Team to inside the Team and redistributes responsibilities of the Project Manager within the Team.



The role of project manager could evolve into project accelerator.
